We are trying to accomplish this through high calorie meals and supplemental feedings of Pediasure.

Please pray with us that someone will fall in love with Eyme and want to adopt her; the Lord will heal her; and that the Lord will give us the wisdom to draw her out, because when Eyme smiles you can see that behind those beautiful little eyes there is love and intelligence.
